

Clifford Road

Before the C20 creation of the Council Estate , the dwellings on Clifford Road began and ended with the old school and the Head 's house [Mr. Bradford 's house] with the cottage next door. Opposite was the village weighbridge , and later the water pumping station . Further along was the traditional boundary , **Ladybridge** , near the old quarry , a place where the youth of the two villages met to contest their manhood and work out their animosities . It is ironical that this was the site chosen for the new school which now caters for the children of both Bramham and Clifford .
