Alleluia!**

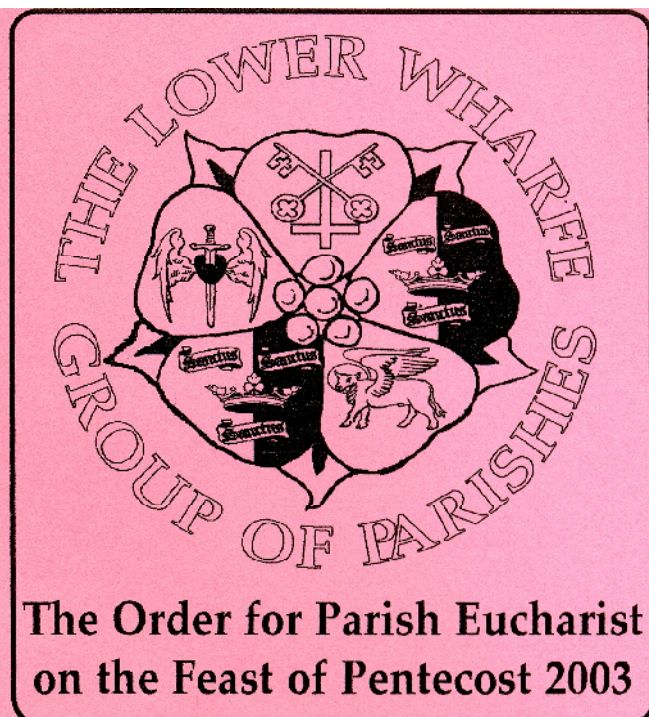
- Priest* O God, who by the resurrection
