

Sports Stars in Bramham

Since the growth of the village over the last 30 years , a number of well - known sportsmen have lived in Bramham :

Joe Jordan, Scottish international centre forward and later Premiership manager, lived in Crag Gardens during his time with Leeds United around 1980.

Paul Parker, fullback with Leeds United , Manchester United , Tottenham Hotspur and England , bought a house in Fine Garth Close , where , after being forced into early retirement after injury, he hoped to set up a physiotherapy clinic in his home. Leeds M.D.C. blocked his plans , and he moved on.

Lucas Radebe , captain of Leeds United and his native South Africa [with whom he played in successive World Cup Finals , 1998 & 2002] , was a very popular resident in Firbeck Road for several years at the end of the century. Lucas could be relied on for a friendly word and an autograph for the local lads.

Richard Blakey, wicket - keeper / batsman , and occasional captain of Yorkshire County Cricket Club [and an England international] , rented Mole End Cottage on High Street for a period during the late 1990 's .
