

Westwood Farm

Farmed in recent decades by the Hills family , West Woods was one of the chief areas of farming within the Bramham Park Estate . Nowadays the tenancy comprises the whole area , whereas in 1818 , as shown on the 1817 map , the fields were subdivided among many tenants . The modern farmhouse , built in 1970 , replaced the previous Clifford Moor Farm , next to the A1 , which was sold as a private residence. At Westwood in recent years Mrs. Muriel Hills has bred fine thoroughbred racing horses .

Next to Westwood , the Hills built , first , a large potato store , followed , in the late 1990 's , by a striking private bungalow with stables . This has been named *Lane Side Farm* , and is the site of a livery stables.
