## Extension to Bramham Hall

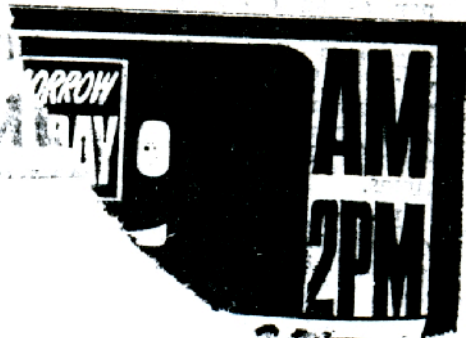
The village hall management committee at Bramham, near Leeds, no longer has to hold its meetings in the kitchen, for today the Chairman of Wetherby Rural Council, the Hon. Mrs. M. A. M. Lane Fox, opened a £1,500 extension to the hall.

Mr. Charles Harry Kendal, chairman of the management committee, explained that plans for enlarging the hall had been on hand for some time: "If we had a function on in the hall, the committee had to meet in the kitchen," he said.

Village organisations have raised money, villagers have contributed and a Government grant of around 50 per cent. of the total cost is expected.
