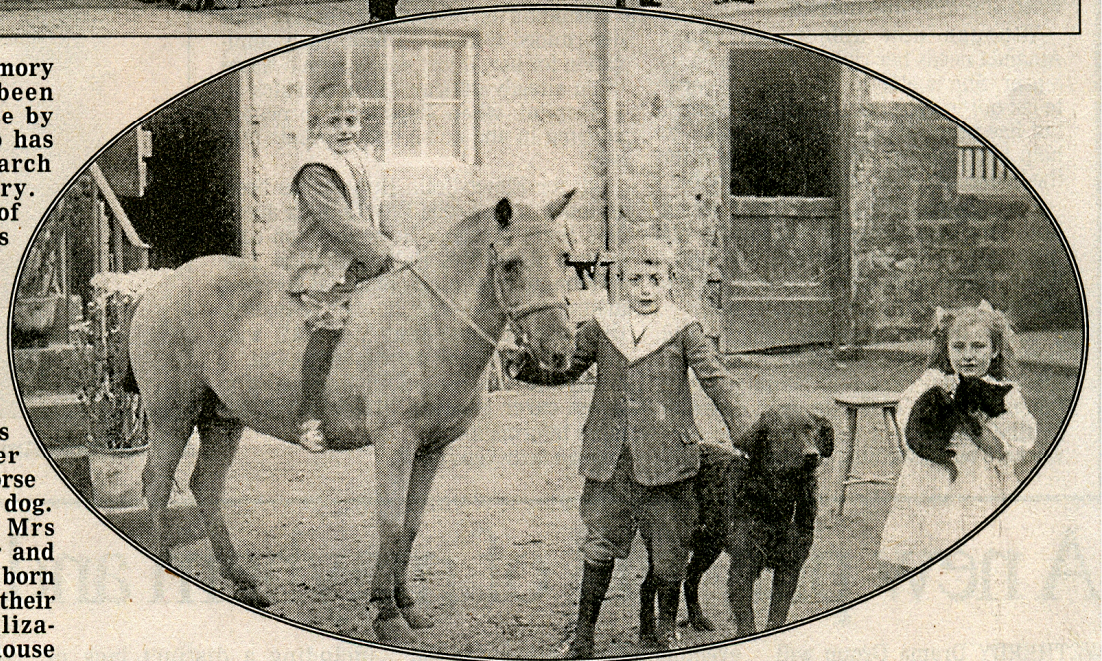


DOWN MEMORY LANE

Getrude Stead was Mrs Doherty's grandmother and all three children were born in the Red Lion where their parents, Henry and Elizabeth, ran this public house until around 1914. Unfortunately, Mr Henry Stead then died and the family had to leave the Red Lion and moved to Shadwell.
