Prospect Bank

Twelve houses [2 with Windmill Road addresses] were built by Ryedale Homes of Malton in 1968 - 9, on land purchased from the Lane Fox Estate for £10,000. Using about 8 different plans with variations, Ryedale produced 12 individual homes, all but 2 of which [nos. 1 & 7] were extended during the period to 2000 [no. 9 had 3 extensions, others 2, some 1].

Ryedale, before being swallowed up during the 1970 's, built similar 'estates 'using the same plans at Middleton / Ilkley [opposite the sports grounds]; Whitwell, NE of Northallerton; and, in brick, Sutton on Forest, north of York.

First buyers paid between c. £8,500 [Nos. 4, 10 & 9] and c. £11,500 [No.3]; each plot was approx. 0.3 acre , charged at a nominal £1000 within the total price. [Ryedale therefore took only £2000 profit from the sale of the plots!]

Most of the houses changed hands, often several times, in the period 1969 - 99, when only two 'original 'families remained [the Turners at 7, Windmill and the Machins at 9, Prospect]. A list of owners of all 12 houses follows, indicating the turnover of houses during this period; approximately 165 people lived here in the 30 year period.
