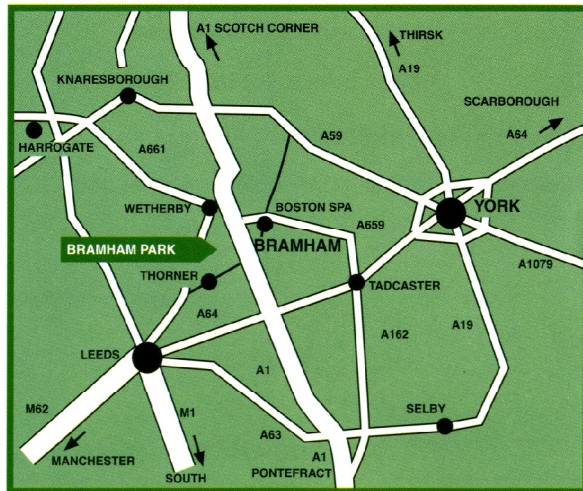

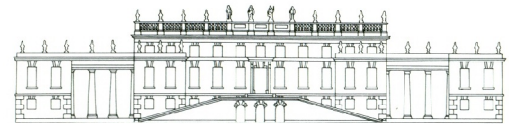

12TH - 15TH JUNE 1997

The Bramham Three-Day Event took place for the first time in 1974. It has progressed over 23 years to International Status (FEI**) attracting many of the world's greatest event riders.

This year, for the first time, leading international course designer Capt. Mark Phillips will be designing the cross-country course, and is sure to incorporate several innovative and challenging fences.

The parkland set in the picturesque rolling countryside of Yorkshire where the Event is held, has been in the Lane Fox family for eight generations, since Robert Benson, the first Lord Bingley, built the House and laid out the grounds in the manner of Versailles in 1698 and George Fox married his daughter. The area has been associated with cavalry exercises from the beginning of the 15th century, so it is appropriate that the horse trials, known in continental Europe as 'The Military Competition' should be held at Bramham.

THE THREE DAY EVENT

Day 1 DRESSAGE

A sequence of movements to test the suppleness and obedience of the horse. To accommodate the large number of entries dressage tests will be performed on both Thursday and Friday.

Day 2 SPEED & ENDURANCE

A stamina test which includes an individual steeplechase of two miles ridden at racing speed and a cross-country course of just under four miles, jumping 31 obstacles including combinations and many other spectacular fences.

Day 3 SHOW JUMPING

The last phase of the competition to test the precision and fitness of horse and rider in completing a course of show jumps after the demanding cross-country phase the day before.

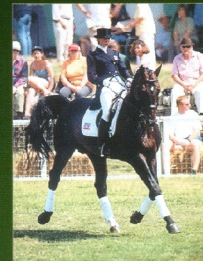
SHETLAND PONY GRAND NATIONAL

Dressage is the fastest growing of all the Olympic Disciplines in Great Britain and we are delighted to be able to show a display to Music at Bramham this year.



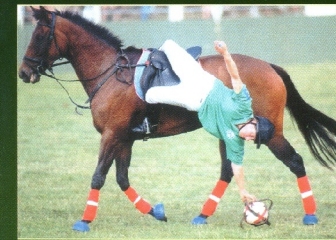
YE OLDE RED TAIL FALCONRY DISPLAY
