

THE NORA ROBINSON COLLECTION

These photographs comprise the Collection donated to the Bramham Archive by the executors of Miss Nora Robinson in September 1996. They are completed by two large lithographs showing Bramham College (reproduced in sketch form in the book “ Bramham --- the Village in Times Past “). The lithographs are on loan to , and hung at , *Bramha Drive School*.

Nora Robinson was born , and lived all her life , in Bramham , where she was employed at , and had strong connections with , Bramham Park. The photographs are thought to have been taken by a member of her family around the turn of the century ; certainly before 1908 , when the the Park was rebuilt after nearly eighty years lying empty from fire damage. Here the dereliction is clearly shown. Interestingly the arrangement of the gardens is quite different from today .

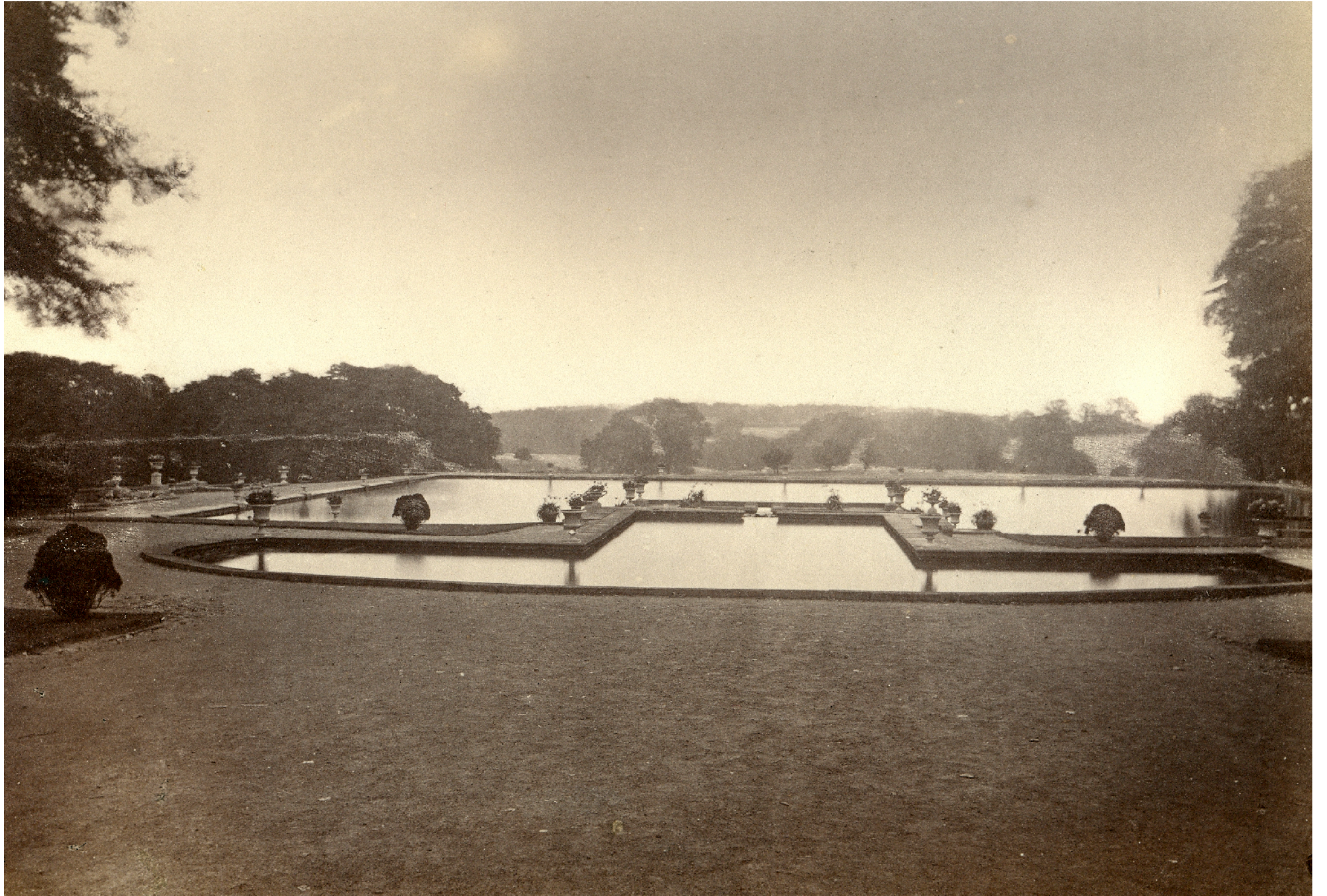

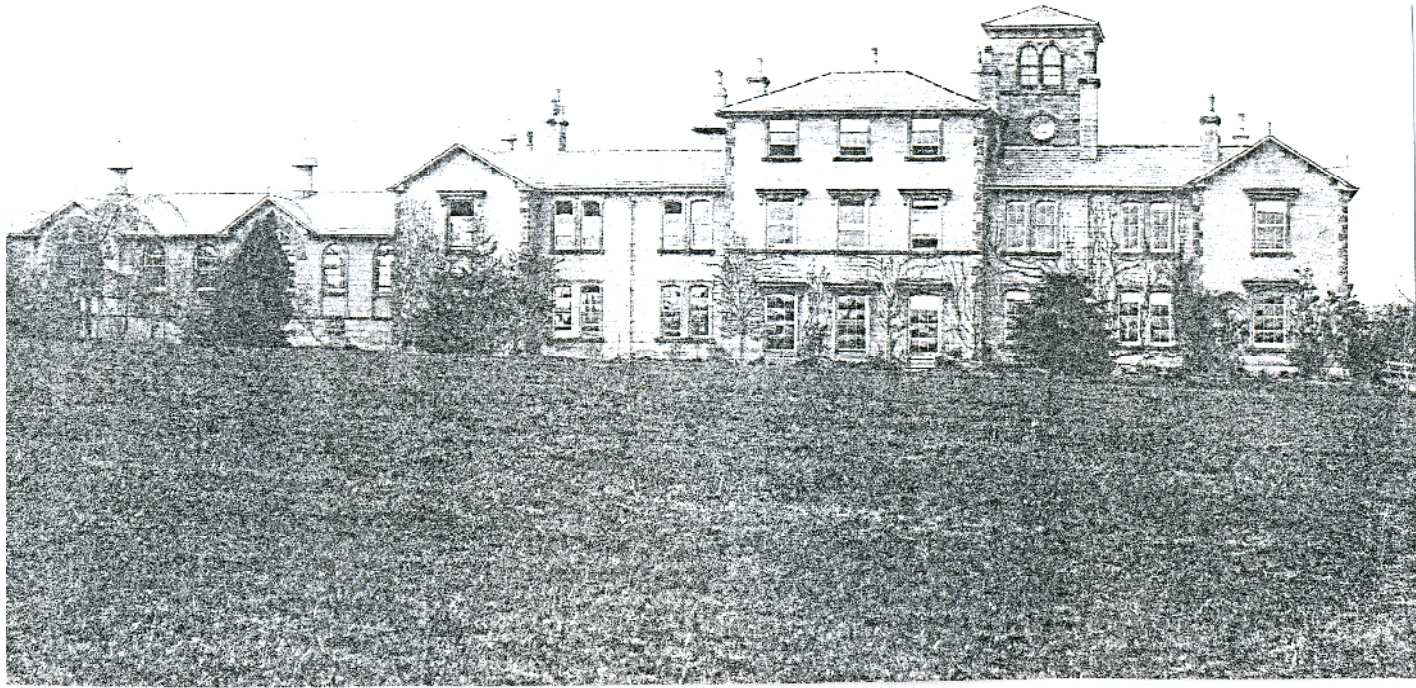












Thorp Ash Grange
