1962-3 Fr. Walker was E. M. for Bramham and Mrs Burton was Deanery Presiding Member and kept in close touch. They had meeting on such things as The Fruits of the Spirit, Children at Prayer. The Blessings of Family Life.

For a while in 1963, 4 and 1965 the M.U. met at Mrs Rolston's house until the Vicarage was completed in June 1966.

1965 and 1966 M.U. members mended cassocks, surplices made and embroidered Purificators and Confirmation Veils.
